Government Policies Impacting Adapter Costs

South Korea's 2024 Eco-Device Act requires all adapters sold domestically to have 85%+ energy efficiency. While raising production costs by 9%, this:

Reduces electricity bills by KRW2,100/year per adapter (KEPCO data)

Pushes suppliers like Samsung and Xiaomi to upgrade tech
