3 Policy Changes Impacting 2025 Prices

Bangladesh's new SREDA guidelines (effective July 2024) will:

- Waive 7% VAT for energy-efficient adapters
- Ban non-UL certified adapters from August
- Offer 10% duty cuts on imports through Mongla Port
