2. Quotes below \$0.70/piece (often counterfeit products).
3. Refusal to share NOM certification documents.

Pro tip: Always ask for a sample kit before finalizing orders. Major brands like Bosch and Huawei now partner with Mexican wholesalers to cut middlemen costs.

For time-sensitive projects, consider express customs-cleared shipments from Lazaro Cardenas port. Though 15% pricier, they ensure 7-10 day delivery versus 30+ days for standard orders.
