Mexico's adapter market has 37% counterfeit products. Always check:

- ? NOM-001-SEDE-2018 certification sticker
- ? Supplier's IMT (Industrial Manufacturing Tax) registration
- ? Partnership with Chinese tech hubs like Shenzhen (ensures component quality)

Pro tip: Request a free sample quotation first. Reputable brands like VoltSafe offer 3 units for factory testing. Last month, Monterrey's Grupo Alfa saved 14% by bulk-ordering through VoltSafe's partner portal rather than
