"Most 'German-engineered' bits sold here are actually Turkish copies," warns Ahmed Kabbaj, a Casablanca drilling engineer. Always verify ISO 9001 certificates. Pro tip: Look for suppliers registered with Morocco's ONEE (National Electricity & Water Agency).
