#2 Atlas Copco: All-Rounder for Mining

Preferred at Rana Gruber's iron mines, these rods reduce replacement cycles by 40%. Ask about their wholesale discounts for 100+ unit orders.

#3 Boart Longyear: Budget-Ready Option

While 15% lighter than Sandvik, these Polish-made rods work for shallow geothermal projects. Basic models start at EUR185/piece.

- Request quotations from at least 2 suppliers
- Compare warranty terms - top brands offer 24+ months
