1. Atlas Copco FlexiROC T25

Used in the Amsterdam Noord/Zuidlijn metro expansion. Local suppliers offer wholesale prices from EUR8,900. Comes with 3-year hydraulic system warranty.

2. Sandvik Dux TH540

Chosen by 7/10 North Sea tunnel contractors. Ask for price quotes through official Dutch distributors to avoid parallel import markups.

3. Epiroc SmartROC T35

20% faster drilling in hard shale areas like Limburg. Maintenance costs run 35% lower than German competitors according to TU Delft studies.

The Chinese-made Furukawa FRD-150 looks tempting at EUR6,200, but our Groningen case study shows 62% higher breakdown rates. Stick to EU-approved brands unless you want weekly repair bills. Rotterdam's BAM Infra recently switched to Sandvik drills, cutting project delays by 17%.
