Check if suppliers participate in ProChile's "Tech Machinery 2025" tax incentive program
Verify warranty coverage for high-altitude performance - many brands void warranties above 1,500m

Coquimbo-based supplier Ferreteria Industrial offers free ROI calculators comparing compressor models. Their recent client, Minera Los Pelambres, saved \$214,000 annually by switching to variable-speed compressors. Current lead time for Atlas Copco units: 6-8 weeks via Antofagasta port.
