1. Base price - Compare specs on depth capacity (100m vs 300m models differ by Rp 1.2B)
2. Warranty - 89% of JIS-standard rigs need repairs in first 18 months
3. Spare parts - Atlas Copco bits cost Rp 8.5M vs local copies at Rp 2.3M
