Current rental costs per month vary by machine capacity:

Compact models (100mm diameter): JPY240,000-JPY320,000

Heavy-duty rigs (500mm+): JPY720,000-JPY1.1 million

Prices in Hokkaido run 12-15% higher than Fukuoka due to transportation logistics. Meanwhile, suppliers like Tokyo Heavy Machinery Co. now offer "ROI packages" with free bits for 6-month rentals.

How Yokohama Port Expansion Cut Drilling Costs by 37%

Contractors at Yokohama's new container terminal used a wholesale guide strategy:

Rented 3 rigs for 8 months (bulk discount)

Split delivery costs with adjacent teams

Used recycled water for cooling systems

This reduced their total core drilling rig rental cost from JPY9.8 million to JPY6.2 million.

What Germany's "Rental-First" Policy Means for Japan
