Required lead time (standard or expedited)

For time-sensitive projects, ask about South Korean suppliers' air freight partnerships. Some offer 3-day delivery to Singapore/Hong Kong ports at \$8.50 per kg - 40% cheaper than European forwarders.

Market Trend Alert

The Korea Trade Insurance Corporation now offers 5% cashback for first-time buyers of industrial components. Combined with the weakening KRW (1,352 per USD in July 2024), this makes parts from Seoul 11% cheaper than Q1 2024 prices. Limited-time offers from major suppliers expire September 30.
