Compare Alibaba vs local vendor prices (bonus: use CBN's 2024 import duty calculator)

Request sealed sample testing from chambers like LCCI

4 Red Flags When Buying Drilling Bits

Aba-based supplier Nwachukwu Drilling Solutions recently sold counterfeit "American-made" bits at 50% market price - all failed within 72 hours. Watch for:

Missing API certification stamps

Vague warranty terms (reputable suppliers offer 6-12 months)

Prices 35%+ below competitors

No physical inspection option

For urgent projects, Port Harcourt suppliers like Brentex PPE keep common tricone bit sizes (4-12 inches) in stock at ?900,000-?3 million. Prefer imports? Lagos ports clear China-shipped bits in 2-3 weeks via DHL's 2024 oil tools clearance program. Always confirm final landed costs - customs fees add 18-27% to quoted FOB prices.
