Taiwan's revised machinery import tax (down to 5.7% from 7.2%) kicks in January. Coupled with new high-speed rail projects, expect drilling bit prices to rise 8-12% by Q3. Taoyuan-based DrillsPro already increased quotes twice this year.

Ready to lock in 2024 rates? Start with free price lists from certified suppliers - most provide same-day quotes via LINE or email. Just avoid the #1 mistake: forgetting to ask about heat treatment guarantees (saves 37% in replacement costs).
