Always verify if suppliers meet Jordan Standards and Metrology Organization (JSMO) certifications. Non-compliant equipment risks 500-2,000 JOD fines under 2024 construction regulations.

For urgent quarry drilling near Madaba last March, Al Nasr Tunneling leased two Sandvik DX800 hammers at 620 JOD/month through a supplier partnership program. The 6-month contract included free operator training - a 1,100 JOD value added at no extra rental cost.
