3. Demand Sample Testing

2024 Price Trends: Act Before July

Steel prices are expected to climb 8% this summer due to EU carbon tariffs. Right now, mid-tier drilling hammers (EUR35-42/piece) from Turkish suppliers like Emsa Makina offer the sweet spot between cost and durability. Volos-based firm Aegean Drilling secured a 12-month price freeze by ordering 600 units in April - a EUR15,600 saving versus waiting.
