Why 2025 Prices Are Lower (But Trickier)

Sweden's push for sustainable mining equipment has slashed import taxes on eco-friendly models. Sounds great, right? Not exactly. Some sellers now mix low-quality parts to meet "green" labels. Last month, 14% of drilling hammers tested in Stockholm failed basic safety checks despite shiny eco-certificates.
