1. Buying rods rated below HRC 58 hardness (causes 40% faster wear in granite)
2. Ignoring EN 10025-6 certification (required for insurance coverage)
3. Choosing FOB pricing over CIF (port delays add \$28-\$55/unit fees)

Over 47 Chilean contractors now use wholesale drilling rod price lists from Alibaba Trade Assurance partners. One buyer in Copiapo reported saving \$210,000 annually through hybrid orders - 60% from Chinese foundries, 40% from local emergency stock.
