Negotiated 17% bulk rental discount

Locked fixed USD pricing despite CNY fluctuations

Final cost: \$214,200 vs initial \$315,000 estimate.

3 Rules for Smart Rental Decisions

German contractor Bauer Group shares their China buying guide strategy:

1. Always request trial reports - Top suppliers like Sany and XCMG provide recent drilling logs showing rig performance.
2. Verify tax-compliant invoices - Avoid customs delays (mainland China-to-Vietnam shipments dropped 22

days using this tactic).

3. Compare per-meter vs monthly rates - For projects over 8km, per-meter pricing saved \$18,000 at Liuzhou mining site.

With China's new VAT rebates (up to 13% for equipment exports until 2026), now's the time to request quotations. A Guangdong supplier's June 2024 promotion offers free maintenance kits - equivalent to 1.2 months' rental savings - for contracts signed before August 30.
