Pro tip: Compare price per drilled foot instead of monthly rates. Hydraulic models often deliver 18% lower operational costs than pneumatic rigs despite higher rental fees. The math? A \$2,500/month rig completing 50ft/day beats a \$1,800 rig doing 30ft/day.
