3 Steps to Avoid Scams When Buying Used

Following these rules saved Yokohama-based company NTech JPY2.7 million last year:

- Demand JETRO certification from suppliers
- Test voltage compatibility (Japan uses 100V)
- Compare at least 3 price lists - prices vary 40% across platforms

Last-Minute Checklist Before Buying

Contact suppliers this week - the weak yen (157JPY/\$) means export demand could push prices up by August.

Always confirm:

Voltage matching your devices

Original manufacturer certification

Return policies covering hidden defects

Ready to save? Use Japan's Recycle Goods Act protection: sellers must disclose an adapter's full repair history by law.
