2. Online Marketplaces: Bargain Hunters' Paradise

Platforms like OLX.pt and eBay Portugal offer the lowest adapter prices in Portugal. Found a working Huawei 65W charger last week for EUR12 - 80% off retail!

3. Bulk Suppliers: Best ROI for Businesses

Porto-based TechRenew sells pallets of 100+ used adapters (mix of Apple, Xiaomi, Dell) at EUR8-15/unit. Minimum order: EUR500. Get quotation via WhatsApp (+351 XXX XXX XXX).

3 Red Flags When Buying Used Adapters

Watch out for:

Sellers refusing safety certifications (look for CE marks)

Prices below EUR10 - likely counterfeits

No return policy - always test before paying

Pro Tip: Seasonal Price Drops

Track prices during January (post-holiday sales) and July (tourist off-season). Last summer, Lisbon's TechFeira market sold certified used adapters at 25% below average price per piece.

Still unsure where to start? Compare 3 quotes minimum. Ask suppliers about bulk deals if needing 10+ units. With Portugal's growing circular economy initiatives, second hand electronics are becoming safer and more accessible than ever.
