Hidden Costs You Can't Ignore

A \$15 adapter might seem cheap until you pay \$5 for voltage converters. German-made adapters often need stabilization gear (+\$8), while Chinese models work directly with Uzbekistan's 220V system. Always ask: "Does this include compatibility fixes?"

Tashkent's largest electronics hub, Mirzo Ulugbek Market, now hosts discount days every Friday. One buyer secured 50 Xiaomi adapters at \$9.70/piece - 37% below retail. For larger orders:

Final Checklist Before Payment

Check the plug type (Uzbekistan uses Type C/F sockets), input voltage range (190V-240V preferred), and safety certifications. A Huawei CP60 adapter priced at \$25 with CE markings beats a \$18 no-brand unit that fried a customer's phone in Andijan last winter.
