Top suppliers like CompressPro PH include free shipping within Metro Manila. Others offer installment plans - a Pasig dealer provides 0% interest for 6 months on tanks over PHP30,000. Remember: second hand doesn't mean low-quality. 78% of buyers report their used tanks lasted 4+ years with basic maintenance.
