- Checked hour meters & maintenance logs
- Tested CFM output on-site
- Negotiated bulk purchase discounts

3 Supplier Red Flags to Avoid

Over 60% of used compressor complaints in Pakistan trace back to:

- Dealers who refuse third-party inspections
- Prices 25% below market average (often indicates tampered meters)
- No clear import paperwork (critical for China/Japan-sourced units)

Smart buyers now request live video checks before payment. Top suppliers like Karachi Plant Zone even offer 30-day returns - rare but worth hunting for. Remember: A PKR 2M compressor that lasts 5 years beats a PKR 1.5M unit dying in 18 months.
