Top suppliers like Yong Fong Hardware provide free delivery for orders above S\$1,000. Meanwhile, Malaysia-based traders often sell 15% cheaper units - but factor in S\$50-S\$80 shipping fees.

Who Offers the Best Value? Market Leaders vs Local Suppliers

Atlas Copco's certified refurbished bits cost 60% less than new units - ideal for tunnel projects. But for budget jobs, Singapore's ReBit Asia sells reliable S\$85/piece models with 3-month warranties. Remember to check BCA-approved suppliers if working on government tenders.

The final tip? Always calculate price per meter drilled instead of upfront cost. A S\$300 bit lasting 500m beats a S\$150 bit needing replacement at 200m. Start requesting quotations this week - suppliers typically reserve best stock for early-month buyers.
