3 Red Flags to Avoid

- ? No maintenance records: Always ask for service history dating back at least 500 operating hours.
- ? "As-is" warranties: Legit suppliers provide 90-180 day guarantees on critical parts.
- ? Suspiciously low cost: If a \$15,000 hammer sells for \$2,100, it's probably stolen or damaged.

Still unsure? Compare live inventory listings on ChileCompra (government procurement portal) or contact the Chilean-German Chamber of Commerce for vetted European exporters. With copper demand projected to grow 4.7% annually (CRU Group), investing in affordable second hand drilling hammers keeps your projects competitive.
