Always request oil analysis reports - machines with >800 operating hours often need part replacements
Compare at least 3 suppliers: Prices vary by 30% for identical models in Den Haag vs Groningen
Ask about Brexit-impacted stock - UK-imported units are 18% cheaper but lack EU compliance guarantees

Pro tip: Many dealers offer wholesale discounts for 2+ units. A Zwolle buyer recently negotiated 15% off by purchasing 4 hammers together. Always confirm if the quoted price per piece includes Dutch BTW tax - some listings show ex-VAT prices to appear cheaper.
