Manufacturer origin proof (e.g., Sandvik, Bauer)

Ultrasonic thickness test reports

30-day mechanical warranty

Local dealers like Hydropress in Katowice sell inspected rods at EUR1,050-EUR1,900 price with free shipping. For bulk orders, German suppliers like Boart Longyear offer EUR980 per piece (5+ units), while Chinese exporters quote EUR720 - but add 14% import tax.
