Verify hydraulic hours like a car odometer - 6,000+ hours means 20% price drop

Use escrow payments until full field testing completes

Market Shock: China's Export Surge Changes Game

Customs data shows 28,000 used rigs entered Australia in Q1 2024 from China - up 330% from 2023! While this floods the market with low-cost options, watch for compatibility with Aussie diesel standards. Tip: Insist on Tier 3/Stage IIIA+ engines.
