Brand: Used SANY rigs cost 15-20% less than Sandvik equivalents

Local vs Imported: Mombasa port-cleared units are 8-12% pricier than stock in Nairobi yards

How to Get the Best Deal (Without Risks)

Request Live Inspection Reports: Top suppliers like HeavyTech Africa provide 50+ point checklists

Compare Supplier Quotes: Prices vary wildly - we've seen \$52K-\$89K for same 2017 Atlas Copco model

Negotiate Warranty: 78% of Nairobi dealers now offer 3-6 month warranties on critical parts

Beware the "Too Good to Be True" Deals

A Kiambu buyer recently lost \$41,000 on a "low-mileage" rig later found to have replaced hour meters. Always verify maintenance logs with OEM service centers in Kenya or Uganda.

The China Connection: Smart Buying in 2024

Chinese used rigs dominate 68% of Kenya's market (Kenya Revenue Authority data). While brands like XCMG and Zoomlion offer cheaper upfront costs, prioritize suppliers who:

- Provide Mandarin-to-English translated service histories
- Have local technicians (check workshops in Industrial Area Nairobi)
- Include ROI calculators based on Kenya's drilling rates (\$120-\$220 per meter)

One dealer even offers 0% import duty deals by consolidating shipments monthly via Mombasa. But hurry - Kenya's proposed 16% VAT on used machinery could hit by Q3 2024. Time your purchase right, and that second hand engineering drilling rig could be your ticket to profitable contracts from Naivasha to Turkana.
