2024 Price Ranges: What's Realistic?

For 80-150HP rigs suitable for Nigeria's soil conditions:

Basic models (2015-2017): ₦18-25M

Mid-tier (2018-2020): ₦26-38M

High-end (2021-2023): ₦40-55M

Pro tip: Chinese suppliers like SANY and Zoomlion offer 15-20% lower prices per piece than European equivalents. But factor in ₦2.5-4M for shipping and customs clearance.

Request inspection videos (360° views + engine startup)

Negotiate FOB terms with 30% upfront payment
