Expect 6-9% price inflation due to EU emissions rules. Older diesel rigs (pre-2017) face resale drops as contractors seek Stage V engines. Yet smart buyers can profit. A 2021 Junttan PM20 sold for:

- EUR85,000 in Q1 2024
- EUR79,900 in July 2024
- Predicted Q1 2025: EUR74,000 (as newer electric models debut)

Watch for "refurbished" vs "as-is" labels. A Poznan dealer recently sold a 2015 Casagrande C6 with new drill rods (EUR58k) versus identical unrestored units at EUR43k. The EUR15k difference paid off - the buyer saved EUR12k vs hydraulic repairs.

ROI Calculation: Used vs New

Average ROI period for Polish contractors:

- o New rig: 5-7 years

- o Used rig: 2-3 years

Case study: A Wroclaw company bought a 2019 Sandvik DP1500i for EUR132k. After 18 months of highway projects, they resold it for EUR118k. Net equipment cost: EUR14k. Try that with a EUR310k new rig!
