Oil analysis reports from the last service

Hour meter verification (aim for under 3,000 hours)

Taiwan EPA emission compliance certificates

Where to Get Reliable 2025 Quotations?

Top Taiwan suppliers like Hota Industrial or Chuan Nueng Machinery offer online price lists. Yet, prices vary wildly--one Kaohsiung vendor quoted NT\$288,000 for a 2018 screw compressor, while a Taichung competitor asked NT\$315,000 for the same model!

Pro tip: Compare with neighboring markets. A used Sullair 600H from China costs 18% less, but Taiwan's import tax adds 10-15%. Meanwhile, Japan-auctioned Hitachi units often skip vital parts like air filters.

The Smart Buyer's Checklist

Before negotiating a second-hand four-wheel screw diesel compressor price in Taiwan:

Test the compressor's air output (CFM/PSI)

Check tire condition (20% of breakdowns come from wheel damage)

Ask for fuel efficiency data (aim for 3-5 liters/hour)

Why Act Now? The 2025 Market Shift

Taiwan's government plans stricter emission rules by Q3 2025--older compressor models may lose resale value fast.
