A Rabat-based drilling team learned this the hard way. They bought a "barely used" 2018 screw compressor for \$14,000, only to spend \$3,200 replacing corroded air filters and a misaligned rotor. Always budget 10-15% of the purchase price for immediate repairs.

Ready to explore options? Start by comparing at least 3 supplier deals and ask about extended payment terms - many Moroccan dealers now offer 90-day credit for registered businesses. With diesel prices stabilizing at MAD 12.5/liter, a fuel-efficient second-hand compressor could be your best ROI move this quarter.
