Ask for ROI proof: How many months until the second-hand compressor pays for itself?

Supplier Checklist: Red Flags vs Green Lights

Avoid sellers who:

- Can't provide VAT invoices
- Rush you to pay cash
- Say "no returns"

Trust suppliers who:

- Offer 3-month warranties
- Share previous owner contacts
- Have warehouses near you (saves TL2,500-TL5,000 in Turkey-wide shipping)

How Turk Traktor Found 52% Savings

Turkey's largest tractor maker bought 7 used 15HP piston compressors from a closed Bursa factory. Total cost: TL315,000 vs TL650,000 for new units. After TL45,000 in part replacements, they've run smoothly for 18 months. Key lesson? Price per piece matters less than total lifecycle cost.
