1. Ask for hydraulic pressure test reports (missing in 42% of Polish listings)
2. Compare fuel efficiency: New DEUTZ engines save EUR1,800/year vs older models
3. Check CE certification - avoid 28% "grey market" units from Belarus

Supplier Smarts: EU vs China Options

German refurbished drills cost 12-18% more but include 6-month warranties. Chinese suppliers like SINOVO offer EUR4,000 models, but you'll wait 3-5 weeks for shipment. Local Polish dealers? Faster delivery, but inspect in person - 1 in 9 units show hidden wear.
