- S\$11,000-S\$15,000 for 20-30 CFM units (construction sites)
- S\$16,500+ for 40+ CFM industrial systems

Pro tip: Importing from Malaysia cuts costs by 12-18%, but check Singapore Customs duties first. A Johor-based supplier recently offered 2021 Kaeser S32 units at S\$13,200 - 15% below local quotes.

How to Get the Best Quotation

Top suppliers like Kian Huat Machinery and Soon Boon Engineering provide free inspections. Last quarter, they helped a Tuas shipyard save S\$4,700 by matching a used Ingersoll Rand SSR EP130 (30 CFM) to their exact PSI needs. Always ask:

Is the diesel engine Euro III/V compliant?

What's the compressor's duty cycle history?

Are after-sales servicing packages available?

With Singapore's BCA Green Mark scheme pushing for energy efficiency, many used compressors now include retrofitted VSD controls. A Kranji recycling plant slashed energy bills by 31% after upgrading a 2017 Atlas Copco GA37 with such kits. Final thought? Pair your price comparison with total cost analysis - that S\$14,000 quote might save more than a S\$10,000 "bargain."
