- 6-month contract: TL1.62 million/month

Pro tip: Ask about Turkey's Renewable Energy Equipment Import Program. Many suppliers discount rentals by 12-18% if you commit to solar-only projects.

"The TL9.4 million (\$313,000) savings let us bid lower on 3 new tenders," says project head Elif Demir.

1. EkoDrill Turkey (Izmir): Specializes in 300m-depth rigs with battery backups. Current promotion: Free transport within Aegean Region.
2. Gunes Enerjili Makina (Ankara): Offers hybrid solar-diesel models. Their GRM-220 model works 18hrs/day on pure solar.

Global manufacturers like China's SunPower Drill also entered Turkey last quarter, offering TL1.1 million/month (
