Negotiating free weekend operator training

Pre-booking 6 months with a 15% discount

They cut total rental expenses by EUR11,340 - enough to fund a secondary borehole.

## 2024 Market Shifts Every Renter Should Know

Denmark's new groundwater mapping law (effective June 2024) requires dual-casing rigs for 80% of projects. This pushes monthly rental costs up by 8-12% for compliant equipment. Early adopters like WellMaster AS are already stocking updated fleets - but availability is tightening.

Yet there's a silver lining: tax rebates of up to 30% apply for rentals supporting green infrastructure. A recent buying guide from Aalborg Energy confirms hybrids (diesel-electric) qualify if emission levels stay below 210g CO<sub>2</sub>/kWh.
